Summary

Introduction

As a community, the City of Dothan feels it can better present information and statistics to those wanting to know more about the community. The purpose of this document is to collect and organize data and information that will help outsiders to the city learn more about the City of Dothan. This document will be broken up into four major sections.

Business Indicators: provides data on the health of the local economy.

Labor and Income: provides data on income, labor force and employment.

Development Trends: provides data on community growth and annexation.

Demographics: provides data on race, households and education.

We hope that providing more information on these aspects of the community can better inform those in and outside of the community on the city's landscape and attributes.

Community Profile

The Dothan area was first settled by Alabama and Creek Indian Nations. In the late 1700's and early 1800's, the area became a popular spot for pioneers to stop on their way to the Western United States. The city was named *Dothan* in 1885 despite being known as *Poplar Head* for much of its existence.

After the cotton crop of Dothan was devastated by the boll weevil in the 1930's, farmer began diversifying the crops they grew. One popular crop among farmers became the peanut. The peanut has become widely associated with Dothan and surrounding areas. Dothan is home to the annual Peanut Festival and is one of the largest peanut producing regions in the nation.

Today, Dothan serves as a hub for the Wiregrass Region of Southeast Alabama. It is located approximately twenty miles north of the Florida – Alabama state line and approximately twenty miles west of the Georgia – Alabama state line. It is approximately 90 miles from both Montgomery, Alabama and the Gulf of Mexico. Because of its location, Dothan is major stop-over for those traveling from North and Central Alabama, and North and West Georgia heading to the beaches of Panama City, FL and Destin, FL.

The City of Dothan lies primarily lies in Houston County with portions of the city extending into Henry and Dale Counties. It currently has a population of 65,496 with the two primary demographics of the city being White (63%) and Black (32%). Much of the recent suburban development lies outside of Ross Clark Circle around highway 84 in the western portion of the city. Future development is likely to occur in this area as well as the northwest portion of the Ross Clark Circle corridor. The core of the city, inside the Ross Clark Circle, is home to an older housing stock, downtown and historic districts.

Business Indicators

ACCRA Cost of Living Index – First Quarter 2011

This index measures the relative prices for goods and services compared to the average (value of 100) for all other participating metropolitan areas in the United States. Overall, Dothan provides a lower cost of living than the average metropolitan area in the United States.




