Rates Effective October 1, 2021

Sec. 102.300 Commercial Wastewater Disposal Services

- (e) Any person having such a permit shall be charged on a volume basis for only domestic sewage and sludge or grease trap waste to be discharged into the sewer system.

Rates are based upon 1,000 gallons

Sec. 102.334 Rates

- (1) The rates for domestic and residential shall be based upon a charge per 1,000 gallons of metered water billed with a minimum service charge based upon a minimum water consumption of 2,000 gallons. The maximum sewer service charge each month shall be based on a water consumption of 15,000 gallons.

Domestic and Residential	per one thousand gallons	\$ 7.17
Minimum Sewer Service Charge	based on 2,000 gallons	\$ 14.34
Maximum Sewer Service Charge	based on 15,000 gallons	\$ 107.55

- (2) The rates for commercial shall be based upon a charge per 1,000 gallons of metered water billed with a minimum service charge based upon a minimum water consumption of 6,000 gallons.

Commercial	per one thousand gallons	\$ 7.17
Minimum Sewer Service Charge	based on 6,000 gallons	\$ 43.02

- (3) The rates for industrial shall be based upon a charge per 1,000 gallons of metered water billed with a minimum service charge based upon a minimum water consumption of 50,000 gallons.

Industrial	per one thousand gallons	\$ 7.17
Minimum Sewer Service Charge	based on 50,000 gallons	\$ 358.50

- (4) The rates for recreational vehicle parks and other transient facilities shall be based upon a charge per 1,000 gallons of metered water billed with a minimum service charge based upon a 2,000 gallons per space.

Domestic and Residential	per one thousand gallons	\$ 7.17
Minimum Sewer Service Charge	based on 2,000 gallons	\$ 14.34

Sec. 102.336 Senior Discount

- (1) Senior citizens who have reached the age of 65, whose sole source of income is Social Security Benefits and that discharge 3,000 gallons of sewage per month or less will receive a \$2.00 reduction in their monthly sewer bill after completion of the required documentation and approval by the finance department. This applies to single unit residential dwellings with individual water meters and will be based upon the metered water consumption at the customer's location.
